Court of Appeal Upholds Anesthesiologist's Liability in Severe Birth Complications Case

In a landmark decision, the Ontario Court of Appeal upheld the liability of an anesthesiologist in a case involving severe birth complications resulting in permanent brain damage for the patient, Sophia Hemmings. The case, *Hemmings v. Peng*, 2024 ONCA 318, scrutinized the actions during a cesarean section.
